Training Purpose

At To Every Tribe, we train our missionaries before they go because we believe effective cross-cultural ministry demands intentional preparation. Our training equips missionaries with the character, theological foundation, and practical skills needed to navigate the complexities of cross-cultural church planting. By focusing on areas like missiology, cultural adaptation, and disciple-making, we ensure our missionaries are not only grounded in the gospel but also capable of building trust, bridging cultural gaps, and fostering long-term relationships. This preparation helps them avoid common pitfalls, strengthens their resilience in challenging environments, and aligns their ministry efforts with a clear strategy for church planting and disciple-making. Ultimately, our goal is to cultivate longevity and effectiveness in our missionaries. ensuring their efforts lead to a sustainable gospel impact among the unreached.

Training Outcomes

The To Every Tribe training program is built around seven core ministry skills, represented by the letter 'E':

- Expositing Scripture: Accurately interpreting and conveying the message of the Bible.
- Expositing Culture: Understanding and engaging respectfully with different cultures.
- Engaging People: Building trust and fostering meaningful relationships.
- 4. **Evangelizing the Lost**: Sharing the gospel in cross-cultural settings.
- Equipping New Converts: Mentoring new believers.
- Establishing Churches: Starting self-sustaining churches in local contexts.
- Exiting with Grace: Transitioning leadership to local believers for long-term growth.

Completion Requirements

Reading Assignments: Trainees are required to complete all reading assignments before each class.

Homework Assignments: All homework assignments must be submitted on time.

Class Attendance: Trainees are expected to attend all training sessions punctually. If a trainee anticipates missing a session due to an emergency, they must notify the Training Hub office as soon as possible.
